

a GLOBEFISH monthly update

Issue 4/2016 April 2016

LATEST TRENDS

Demand for fishery products was strong in the EU during Holy Week, but has slowed down since, especially for the traditional seafood products such as klipfish. However, overall demand for seafood seems to be higher than last year, and further price increases are likely, especially for tuna, cephalopods and freshwater species.

GROUNDFISH

The Norwegian skrei (spring cod) fishery, which runs from January until April, started slowly this year, but picked up quickly in February and March. The slow start at the beginning of the year was partially due to the fact that the spawners were somewhat slow in reaching the Lofoten and Vesterålen regions in northern Norway, and also due to poor weather, as most skrei fishing is done by small coastal vessels. In early April, however, fishers reported strong catches of high-quality, large fish, with such high volumes landed that prices for smaller sizes were higher than their larger counterparts in mid-March. In general, prices for fresh cod are high at the moment, and demand for this high-quality fish is very good in Europe.





The European Fish Price Report, based on information supplied by industry correspondents, aims to provide guidance on broad price trends. Price information is indicative and should be used only for forecasting medium- and long-term trends. FAO is not responsible for any errors or omissions.

After Holy Week, consumption of traditional wet-salted products typically declines in Southern European countries, and demand for wet-salted cod fillets from frozen raw material (Gadus macrocephalus) has weakened recently. As a result, it is expected that prices that have been sky-high in recent months will fall back soon. For wet-salted cod fillets (Gadus morhua) from fresh raw material, the situation is similar, with limited demand, decreasing prices, and full producer inventories (Faroe Islands and Iceland). Prices for frozen saithe fillets are also reported to be on a downward trend after pre-Easter hikes.

Demand for Alaska Pollack has been strong on the Moscow market, with catches sold quickly and an increasing price trend. The market in Vladivostok, meanwhile, is currently characterized by decreasing prices as the new catch is expected on the market soon. In Poland, demand for cod has been strong but supply limited, which has led to price increases on this market.


Turbot prices in the Spanish market picked up quite sharply in April 2016, and smaller sizes reached an all-time record high of EUR 9.25/kg, which is 60% higher than the corresponding price last year. For larger sized turbot, however, prices are still about EUR 0.80/kg below the April 2015 price level. Prices for PBO hake fillets blocks on the Spanish market, meanwhile, remain stable compared with last year, although prices for



hake minced blocks have increased quite a lot due to huge demand and widespread shortage.

TUNA - BILLFISHES


The supply of tuna to the canneries remained slow in April and prices rose sharply. The situation is expected to stay tight, and further price hikes are likely. Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific continues to be affected by bad weather and remains slow. While most Thai Canneries will be closed for 5 days from 13 to 17 April due to the Songkran Holidays, they are still reporting moderate-to-low raw material inventories.






The situation in the Eastern Pacific market is similar to the Western and Central Pacific. Fishing remains poor and raw material inventories are at a low level. Catching in the Indian Ocean is improving but mainly for skipjack. Local canneries continue to hold healthy material raw inventories. It is also reported that some fish have been transshipped and diverted to the Bangkok market as prices there are higher than in the Seychelles.

Following the trends in Bangkok and Manta, skipjack and yellowfin prices have been rising on the Mahe market also. Fishing in the Atlantic Ocean is not showing any sign of improvement, remaining at a low-to-moderate rate. Raw material inventories in local canneries are now reported to be moderate-to-low.






SMALL PELAGICS

Pacific herring is in strong demand on the Moscow market, and as traditional Western suppliers such as Iceland and Norway are excluded from supplying the market with Atlantic herring, prices are likely to rise strongly. Price increases have also been reported for herring and sprats on the Polish market. Meanwhile, demand for pelagic fish in the Near East is strong, and Oman is unable to sell to Europe due to the low value of the euro.


CEPHALOPODS


Peruvian giant squid landings have declined by about 20% as a result of El Niño, resulting in tighter squid supplies, and squid prices are on the rise on European markets. Octopus supplies are quite good, but demand exceeds supply, and prices are on the way up.



CRUSTACEANS

Sales of shrimp were very strong during Holy Week in Spain, leading to price increases. In Argentina, exports were reported to be very strong in the first quarter of this year, far ahead of the first quarter of 2015. These exports were mainly destined for the Asian market at discounted prices and, as a result, cold storage holdings are low. With the start of the new shrimp season now approaching, prices are expected to go up, at least during the next couple of months.







BIVALVES

The bouchot season has come to an end, and only limited quantities are available on the market. The shortfall in local production is being filled by Irish organic rope mussels. Dutch bottom mussels are also coming to the end of the season, with Irish mussels also serving as a substitute for this species on the French market. *Galloprovencialis* mussels are also present on the French market, mainly in low-price MAP trays, and helping to fill the gap in French and Dutch production of edulis.

SALMON

Prices for Norwegian farmed salmon on the NASDAQ salmon index were at NOK 62/kg for fresh whole Atlantics by week 14 of this year, around NOK 20 higher than the

same week last year. This sharp increase is a reflection of tightening global supply, driven to a large extent by the heavy mortalities at Chilean farms caused by the red tide algal blooms in early 2016. The effect on Norwegian export revenues has been significant, with the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC) putting the total value for Q1 2016 at NOK 13.4 billion, 21% higher than the same period in 2015, even as volumes fell



6% to 227 464 tonnes. This record-breaking performance by Norwegian exporters has been supported by favourable currency trends and continuing demand growth from old and new markets. In particular, the core EU market has so far remained strong in the face of rising prices, spending 23% more on Norwegian salmon in Q1 2016 as volumes fell by 5%. Poland and France maintained their position as the top two destinations for Norwegian product, but Italy is notable in having posted a 61% increase in value terms and an 11% increase in volume over the same period. The UK farmed salmon sector, recovering from a dip in 2015, also stands to benefit from the higher prices and the relatively lower availability of fish.

The outlook for European salmon producers is extremely positive for the remainder of 2016, with prices expected to remain around the NOK 60 mark at least until June, although a drop can be expected as late-summer harvesting begins. Overall though, the consistent upward revisions of Fish Pool forward prices over the last few months suggests a market that is still trying to come to terms with the consequences of a severe supply shock at a time when global demand for salmon has never been higher. While the high prices are good news for producers, processors are suffering heavily

from soaring raw material prices, and buyer resistance will inevitably increase as the costs are passed down.

TROUT

The Norwegian farmed trout industry is undergoing a recovery following the closure of the important Russian market in August 2014. Marketing efforts, and the divergence of trout prices from those of salmon, is stimulating demand in European countries as well as other markets in Asia and the US. Compared with Q1 2015, the NSC reports a 99% increase in total value of Norwegian exports of trout in the same period





this year, with volume up 91% as higher production at farms boosts supply.

FRESHWATER FISH

The cold winter in China created supply problems for the tilapia market, which are likely to continue well into the third quarter of this year. As a result of the shortage, prices have continued climbing, and will likely stay high until the summer.

Similarly, droughts in the Mekong Delta have resulted in lower pangasius production and prices are expected to





start picking up after a long period languishing at extremely low levels.

Supplies of Nile perch are also low at the moment, and frozen prices are expected to start picking up due to strong demand from Japan and the EU. Carp sales and prices are reported to be stable on the Hungarian market, with no sales promotion activity taking place.



SEABASS - SEABREAM - MEAGRE

The improvement in prices for farmed seabream and seabass that took place over the course of 2015 has been largely sustained so far this year, with the effects reflected positively in the balance sheets of Greek aquaculture companies. Greek export revenues for both species combined remained approximately flat year-on-year in the first two months of 2015, while volumes fell slightly.



Meanwhile, Turkish export volumes for the same period were up 22%, despite expectations of an overall fall in production. This is likely the result of faster growth rates following a mild winter, as well as better prices on international markets made more appealing for producers by the weak Turkish lira. The Italian market, in particular, has been noticeably shifting its import preferences towards Turkish fish, importing almost 40% more of relatively cheaper Turkish product in 2015 compared with the previous year. In Spain, domestic production has increased this year – more so in the case of bream - and this is putting some pressure on prices, significantly so for medium sizes. This surplus volume will likely overflow to some extent into other European markets, but prices should remain at sustainable levels overall, with the short-term trend in line with the typical climb to the mid-summer price peak.
