EUROPEAN PRICE REPORT



Latest trends

Easter, and the Holy Week just before Easter, are a main consumption period for fish products. This year, consumer demand is even stronger than normal, maybe because Easter is quite late this time around. Prices went up strongly during the last month in response to various currency fluctuations.

The impact of potential US tariffs on fish products is being felt, at least as an initial reaction to the announced 20 percent tariffs for products from Canada, Mexico and the European Union. The Barcelona Seafood Show next month presents an opportunity for companies normally exporting to the United States to find new market outlets. For example, Mexico has announced that a delegation will be sent to the event to explore potential buyers in Europe for their fish products.

Norway exported fisheries and aquaculture products worth NOK 44 billion in the first quarter of 2025, an increase of NOK 3.5 billion (+9 percent) compared with the same period last year. This first quarter has been characterized by increased export volumes for salmon; high prices for cod, mackerel and snow crab; and strong value growth to the United States of America and China. In addition, the Norwegian krone was weaker in the first quarter than in the same period last year, which has also helped to increase the value of exports measured in Norwegian kroner. Exports to the US market increased strongly by 11 percent, probably due to exporters shipping as much as possible before the new tariffs take effect. The United States has imposed a 16 percent tariff on Norwegian fisheries and aquaculture exports, including salmon, mackerel, halibut, and other products. This tariff is expected to significantly increase costs for American consumers and disrupt Norwegian exports. Norwegian producers are facing uncertainty, with some shipments, although already on the way to the United States, becoming millions of dollars more expensive before arriving.

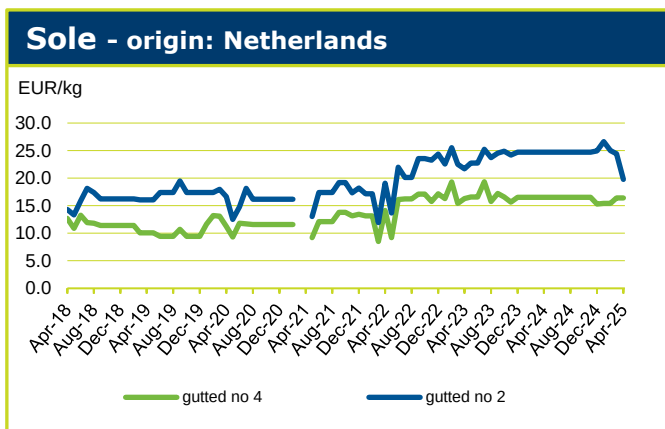

GROUND FISH

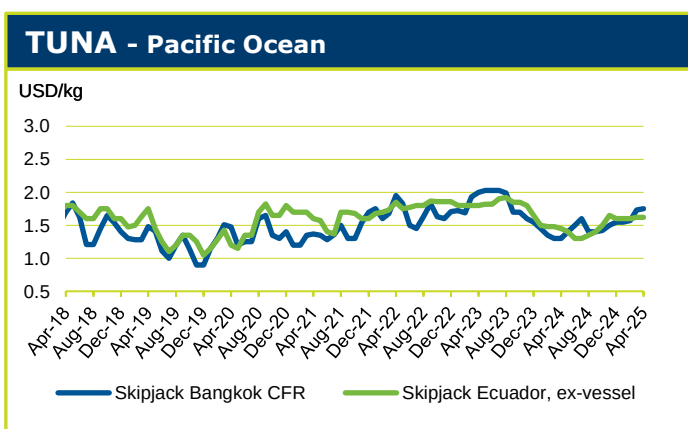
Due to improved temperatures in Southern Europe, consumption of cured cod [salted cod fillets from frozen raw material (*Gadus macrocephalus*) and wet-salted cod fillets (*Gadus morhua*) made from fresh raw material of Faroese and Icelandic origin] is decreasing as it is very much linked to traditional recipes. Another factor for the declining consumption of cured cod is that the raw material price of cod (*Gadus morhua*) has increased significantly due to lower landings in Norway. The exception is Easter Friday, which will see a spike in the consumption of the product.

Norwegian cod is subject to a 25 percent quota reduction in 2025. Not only has this affected the entire value chain on the wild-catch side in the first quarter of the year, less fish in the market has led to increased competition for raw materials. The fact that there was nevertheless a slight increase in the export value of cod is because the price level was at a record high, which compensated for the fall in volume.



TUNA - BILLFISHES

Fishing in the Western and Central Pacific has improved slightly to the poor-to-moderate level but the continued low supply situation has led to rising prices for skipjack. This is despite the poor demand from Thai canneries for finished goods and the additional uncertainty related to the reciprocal tariffs announced by the United States.



TUNA – BILLFISHES (cont.)

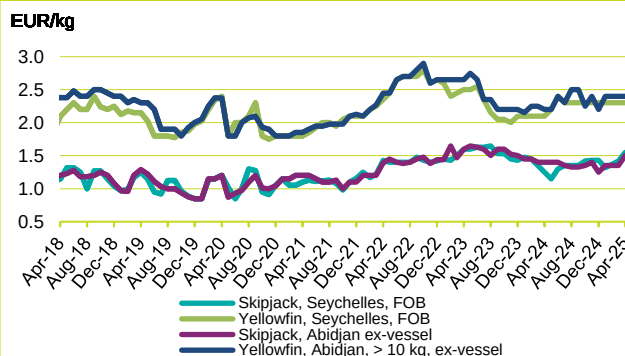
Catching in the Indian Ocean remains at the moderate-to-good level. As yellowfin constitute a higher percentage of the harvest, their prices have dropped while rises are seen for skipjack.

The 45-day International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic Tuna (ICCAT) Fish Aggregation Device (FAD) closure in the Atlantic Ocean started on 17 March. Fishing remains slow and with a higher percentage of yellowfin. Local canneries remain short of raw material. Prices of skipjack have increased sharply due to the shortage of raw material while yellowfin prices remain stable.

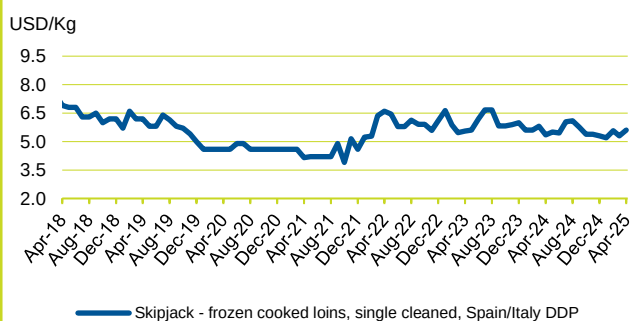
Fishing in the Eastern Pacific Ocean continues to be good and raw material inventories at local canneries remain at the healthy level. Skipjack prices are stable while yellowfin prices are up.

European prices for skipjack continue to increase, following the trends in the Indian and Atlantic Oceans. Reflecting these higher price levels for round fish, the price for cooked, single-cleaned skipjack loins has gone up sharply by USD 300 per kg. Yellowfin prices remain stable.

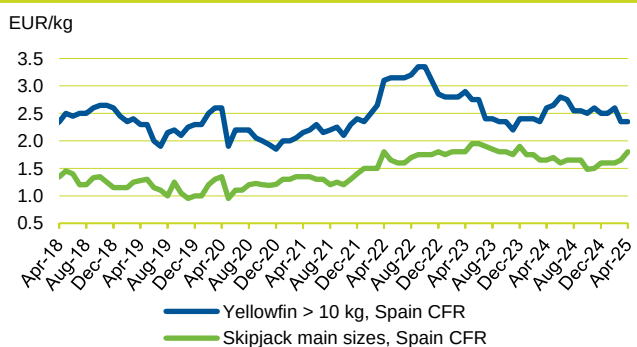
TUNA - Indian/Atlantic Oceans

TUNA - Spanish canneries

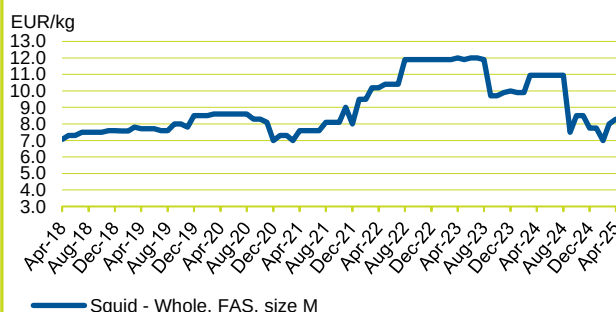


CEPHALOPODS

Squid catches in South Africa remain very poor. Consequently, very little product is available for shipment; prices are up by about EUR 0.30 per kg, reaching a sky-high level.

Octopus prices are high due to good demand during the Easter festivity. Indonesian octopus is starting to be diverted to the European Union and China, as the US market is becoming unattractive due to the new tariffs. At the moment, octopus production in Indonesia is low, and catch volumes are not stable, varying by catching area.

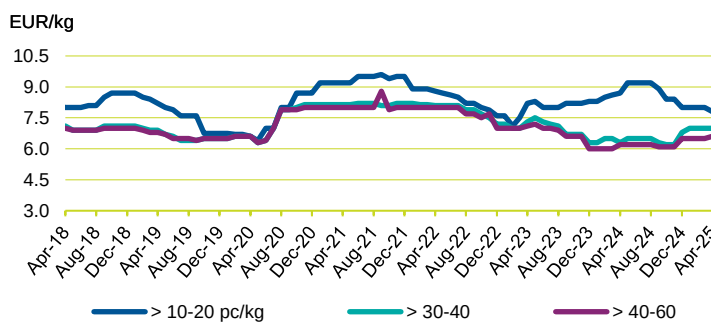
SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa



CRUSTACEANS

Argentinean shrimp prices are stable, as the northern fleet is not fishing at the moment. Overall, prices of large shrimp have declined by EUR 0.20 per kg, while medium-sized shrimp are stable and small shrimp are seeing an increase in price by EUR 0.30 per kg.

US tariffs are having an important impact on the shrimp market, particularly affecting Indian shrimp exports. India, the largest supplier of shrimp to the United States, is facing a 26 percent tariff, causing exporters to look at alternative markets like China and the European Union to mitigate losses. In addition, the reduced demand is forcing them to lower prices by 10 percent, while shrimp farmers are experiencing financial distress due to rising costs and uncertain sales. Ecuadorian shrimp exporters, on the other hand, benefit from lower tariffs, making their products more competitive in the US market.



CRUSTACEANS (cont.)

The shrimp industry in Indonesia is also heavily impacted by the US tariffs. The United States is extremely important for Indonesian shrimp producers, absorbing about 70 percent of their exports. Not surprisingly, the announcement of high tariffs, which arrived just during the Eid holidays in early April, created panic in the market. Some producers and traders were considering lowering prices in order to stay competitive in the US market, while others just went for a wait-and-see approach. The latter left the shrimp in the ponds, despite the fact that feed prices are very high. It turned out that the wait-and-see policy was the wiser option as ultimately, a tariff of only 10 percent was imposed for a three-month period. Importers in the United States have been asking for lower prices, but the producers are keeping their prices stable as there is no margin for lowering the prices due to the high costs. In fact, if anything, the prices need to be rebalanced in order to ensure fairness for farmers, markets and packers. At the same time, there is a clear sense in the industry that the country needs to look for other markets. In the European market, prices for Indonesian shrimp have declined by USD 0.10 per kg due to the low value of the US dollar, which translated into 10 percent lower prices expressed in Euro.

BIVALVES

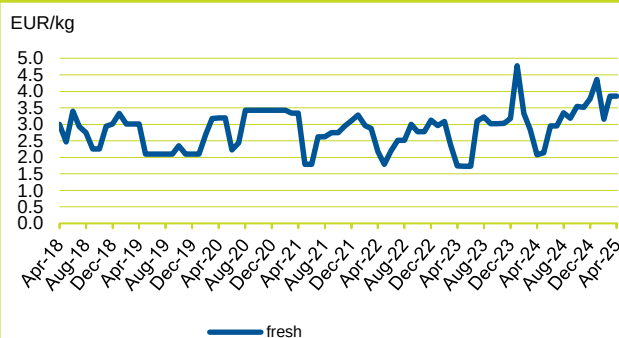
The global scallop market is projected to grow significantly, reaching USD 17.5 billion by 2025, and driven by sustainability efforts, aquaculture expansion, as well as increasing demand in emerging markets. France reports good market conditions for scallop during this Easter period.

The Po River region continues to be Europe's largest clam harvesting area, where 1 800 fishers work to maintain a delicate balance between economic activity and environmental preservation. On the other hand, mucilage is suffocating the wild clam production in the Adriatic Sea, causing them to be smelly and driving customers away.

SMALL PELAGICS

Norwegian small pelagic exports went up in value during the first quarter of 2025. Mackerel shipments reached NOK 1.7 billion which is 54 percent higher than the value recorded in the same period of last year. Herring also grew in value by 12 percent to reach NOK 1.3 billion although in terms of volume, Norway exported 67 320 tonnes, 8 percent less than in the same period of 2024. One has to go back to 2015 to find a lower export volume; but at the same time, the value is the fourth highest ever. Poland, Egypt and Germany were the largest markets for herring in the period under review.

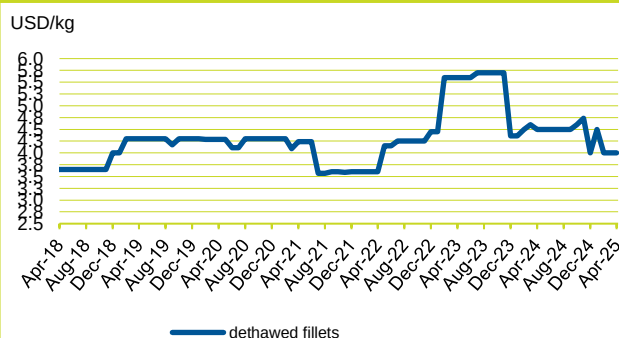
Mackerel - in Italy, origin: France



FRESHWATER

The pangasius market in Europe is experiencing steady growth in 2025 so far, driven by increasing demand for affordable seafood and sustainable aquaculture practices. Viet Nam remains the leading exporter of pangasius, supplying a significant portion of Europe's imports. Consumers are drawn to pangasius for its mild flavour, versatility and cost-effectiveness, making it a popular alternative to premium fish like salmon and tuna. Retail and foodservice sectors continue to drive demand, with frozen fillets being the most sought-after product. Meanwhile, trade regulations and sustainability concerns continue to influence market dynamics, prompting producers to adopt improved aquaculture techniques.

Pangasius - in Italy, origin: Viet Nam





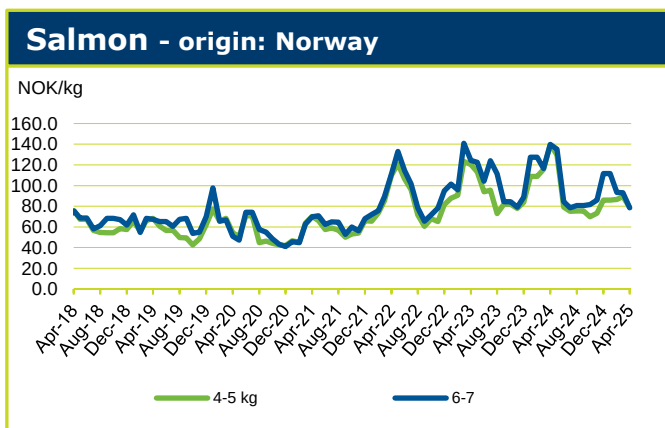
FRESHWATER (cont.)

Total exports of frozen whole pangasius from Viet Nam increased strongly in 2024 to 168 000 tonnes, some 40 000 tonnes more than in 2023. The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland absorbs some 3 500 tonnes of frozen whole fish per year but the most popular product form remains frozen fillets, particularly in the European Union. Total exports of frozen fillets were 700 000 tonnes in 2024, 100 000 tonnes more than in 2023, although at the same level as 2022 exports. Among the European countries, the Kingdom of the Netherlands is the main importer with 20 000 tonnes in 2024, but most of this quantity is sent to Spain and Germany.

SALMON

The first quarter of 2025 has been very positive for Norwegian salmon, according to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC). Favourable biological conditions, including seasonally high sea temperatures, have resulted in strong growth in production and increased harvest volumes compared to the first quarter of last year. The greater availability of fish has contributed to a boost in exports to some of Norway's most important markets.

During the period under review, Norway exported 285 163 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 29.5 billion (EUR 2.57 billion), representing a 16 percent increase in volume and a 6 percent increase in value compared to the same period last year. The main markets during this period were the United States, Poland and France.





SALMON (cont.)

In March alone, Norway exported 102 900 tonnes worth NOK 10 billion (EUR 869 million), marking a 27 percent increase in volume and 8 percent increase in value compared to March 2024.

NSC data, as reported by the Undercurrent News Price Portal, recorded that fresh Atlantic salmon FOB prices for export sales at the Norwegian border reached NOK 89.43 (EUR 7.79) in week 12 of 2025, remaining largely stable compared to the previous week. Despite three non-consecutive weeks with price increases, the overall trend since the beginning of 2025 has been downward, with prices starting at NOK 125.63 (EUR 10.72).

TROUT

The NSC reported strong Norwegian trout exports in the first quarter of 2025. A total of 19 164 tonnes were exported, valued at NOK 1.8 billion (EUR 156.5 million). This represents an increase of 39 percent in volume and 33 percent in value compared with the same period in 2024. The main destinations were Ukraine, the United States and Thailand.

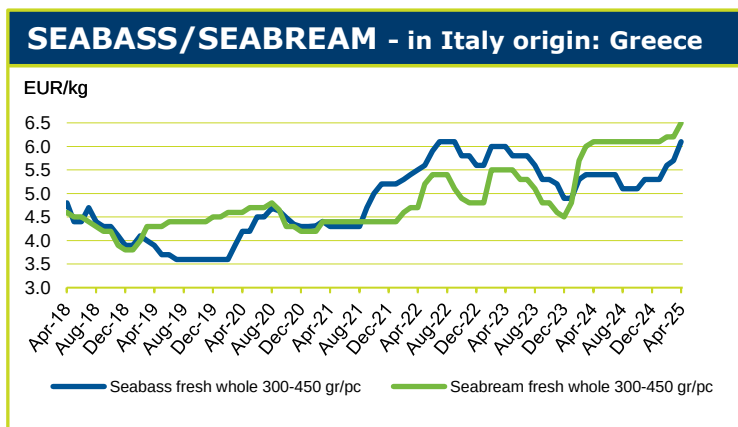
Trout was priced below salmon during the first quarter, which increased its competitiveness as a raw material for the processing industry in Poland. The species is processed into both smoked and fresh products, destined for domestic consumption and export.

In March alone, exports reached 6 100 tonnes worth NOK 551 million (EUR 47.9 million), up by 31 percent in volume and 17 percent in value year-on-year. According to NSC data disseminated by Undercurrent News Price Portal, weekly volumes and FOB prices regarding sales to export markets at the Norwegian border showed that HOG fresh Norwegian trout reached NOK 81.11 (EUR 7.07) at week 12 of 2025. This represented a decline of 3.47 percent compared to the price registered in the previous week. As mentioned in the March edition of the European Price Report, price trends in 2025 continue to show irregular patterns, with fluctuations occurring almost weekly since the beginning of the year.

SEABREAM/SEABASS

Seabass exports from Greece recovered in 2024. Some 54 500 tonnes were exported during the year, which is 15 percent more than in 2023 when the Greek production had experienced several problems. The main importing country for seabass from Greece continued to be Italy, closely followed by Spain. On the other hand, seabream exports from Greece experienced a significant decline in 2024, with 64 100 tonnes compared to 73 500 tonnes in 2023. Spain was the main importing country for seabream in 2024, taking almost 20 000 tonnes, followed by Italy with 19 000 tonnes.

Türkiye is an important seabass producing and exporting country. In 2024, exports were 53 900 tonnes, which compares to 44 400 tonnes in 2023 and 40 900 tonnes in 2022, showing a continuous upward trend. Last year, Greece was the main market for Turkish seabass with its imports of 8 900 tonnes filling the gaps created by lower domestic production. Italy was the second biggest destination for exports of seabass. Turkish seabream exports in 2024 amounted to 58 500 tonnes, just two percent higher than the 2023 figure.
