Latest trends


The 31st edition of Seafood Expo Global/Seafood Processing Global, the world's largest and most diverse fisheries and aquaculture trade event which took place in Barcelona from 6–8 May 2025, brought together 35 000 industry professionals. For three days, suppliers and buyers around the world discussed the latest food trends and innovations, and explored potential solutions to the major challenges facing the industry. This year, the Expo brought together 2 187 exhibiting companies from 87 countries and 68 regional pavilions in more than 51 217 net square meters of exhibit space. The economic impact for the city is estimated to be more than 156 million Euros. Seafood Expo Global exhibitors showcased the most recent innovations in fisheries and aquaculture spanning fresh, frozen, canned, value-added, processed and packaged products.

The European market is preparing for the holiday season, which traditionally means good demand, as fish is sought-after by tourists to the Mediterranean countries. Prices have shown a strong increase in both EUR and USD due to limited supply, especially from capture fisheries worldwide. In this price report, some 23 percent of the products showed higher levels as opposed to declines for 16 percent.




Clam (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) prices continue to increase in Italy. Due to the well-known problems with the blue crab invasion, production is very low these days and the wholesale price of live clams reached a record high of EUR 17.50 per kg in the Milan wholesale market. This species is thus pricing itself out of the market. The traditional summer dish *spaghetti alle vongole* is at risk.

Small pelagics



Prices of Mediterranean small pelagics are going down, as the sector enters the main producing period. Demand is moderate, leading to price declines for fresh sardines and anchovies by about EUR 1.50 per kg.

Tuna


In 2024, the EU market recorded an increase in imports of higher-value non-canned tuna, consisting mainly of frozen fillets with a smaller volume of air-flown fresh tuna. Japanese restaurants were the main users of fresh tuna while much of the whole frozen tuna was used to process end-products. The top import markets for frozen tuna fillets were Spain, France, Italy, Portugal and the Kingdom of the Netherlands.

The overall demand for prepared and processed tuna in the European Union and other markets in Europe remained steady during 2024, with increased imports.


European Union imports of semi-processed cooked loins and ready-to-eat tuna totalled 708 805 tonnes valued at USD 4.21 billion, in comparison with 645 717 tonnes and USD3.97 billion in 2023. The top markets in ranking were Spain, Italy, France, Germany and the Kingdom of the Netherlands. Nearly 26 percent of these imports (188 400 tonnes) comprised semi-processed raw materials (cooked frozen loins) brought in by producers in Spain, Italy, France and Portugal to produce ready-to-eat products. The leading suppliers were China, Ecuador, Papua New Guinea, the Philippines and Solomon Islands.

Meanwhile, EU tuna canners exported 251 100 tonnes of end-products (mostly intra-EU trade) valued at USD 1.82 billion. The extra-EU markets were the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Canada, Switzerland, the United States of America, Morocco and Saudi Arabia.


TUNA - Pacific Ocean

Crustaceans


Although the demand for shrimp in Europe has not yet started and stocks remain plentiful, the lack of news about the start of the Argentinean shrimp season is helping to keep prices stable.

This month, packers in the United States are aggressively buying raw material due to uncertainty regarding US tariff policy in June. Indonesian shrimp farmers are opting to wait and see what will happen while at the same time, trying to balance the potential output from their ponds in order to gain the best trading advantage. There are two possible upcoming scenarios: (i) in cases where the tariff rate is raised to 15 percent and higher, raw material prices may be lowered. However, if too much shrimp is produced in June and prices fall below


a certain level, the farmers would see little advantage under such circumstances; or (ii) if the tariff rate is maintained at 10 percent, prices may be higher because raw material supplies will decrease. Currently, prices of raw material are on the high side because US packers do not want to lose this opportunity to increase their stockholdings.

Demand for lobster is moderate at the moment and prices are going down, which is normal during this period of the year. Supplies are mostly from Canada and the United States. Prices of live lobster (*Homarus americanus*) have declined sharply by more than EUR 2.00 per kg.

CRAB - in France, origin: Europe






Catches of squid in South Africa remain extremely poor and the season is now closed until 30 June. While hoping to see better catches after June, South African producers are very unhappy as overall squid prices are going down, in part due to good supplies from South America.

Due to the low season and unstable catching volumes in some areas, octopus prices remain high. With a US tariff rate of 10 percent, more supplies from Indonesia will be diverted away from the United States to the European Union and China.


SQUID - in Italy, origin: South Africa

Pangasius - in Italy, origin: Viet Nam




Despite some dips, demand for pangasius in the United Kingdom has generally remained steady, with environmental concerns and sustainability becoming increasingly important to consumers. Vietnamese exporters continue to dominate the market, with most of the pangasius entering as frozen fillets through importers and wholesalers. In the first quarter of 2025, UK imports of pangasius fillets were 3 500 tonnes, a 5 percent increase over the same period of 2024, but less than during the first quarter of 2023. Total value was USD 13 million in the first quarter of 2025, down by USD 500 000 from the same period of 2024, indicating a decline in the prices of pangasius during the first months of the present year.

Groundfish


Cod prices are very high at the moment due to lower fishing quotas. Cured cod shows stable market prices while demand is going down, as is usual during the warmer period of the year.

The Pacific hake spring season recently started, with the first catches comprising mainly small sizes. Processors in Alaska are ready to start operations in the following weeks. Prices in the




Spanish market for Pacific hake went up by EUR 0.10–0.30 per kg due to strong demand after months of stable prices. Hake from Namibia also reported a small increase in prices (EUR 0.10 per kg).

Other hake products in the Spanish wholesale market experienced an impressive increase in May 2025, going up by EUR 2.00 per kg.

Salmon

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), April 2025 marked a record month in terms of export value for Norwegian fisheries and aquaculture products, with salmon as the main contributor. Despite global trade uncertainties and falling prices, salmon exports were boosted by increased availability and robust demand in key overseas markets.

Norway exported 106 339 tonnes of salmon in April, generating NOK 10 billion (EUR 837 million), which represents a year-on-year increase of 34 percent in volume and 3 percent in value. Salmon alone accounted for 71 percent of the total export value during the month.

The increase in harvest volume is attributed to higher sea temperatures and improved biological conditions compared with April 2024, leading to more fish of superior quality being available. This bigger supply has shifted trade flows from European destinations (with Poland in the lead) towards other international markets such as the United States and China. In particular, April 2025 exports to China reached an all-time high of 8 224 tonnes, an increase of 188 percent compared with the same month last year, while the value grew by 88 percent. Cumulative exports to China so far in 2025 (up to April) totalled 26 000 tonnes, up 106 percent year-on-year.


The United States also registered significant gains. During January to April, Norway exported 29 000 tonnes of salmon to the US market worth NOK 4.4 billion (EUR 368 million), making it the largest market by value so far this year and accounting for 11 percent of total salmon exports.

Although overall export volumes increased, salmon prices continued their downward trend.

The average price for fresh whole salmon in April 2025 was NOK 84.60 (EUR 7.08) per kilogram, 29 percent lower than in the same month of 2024. The NSC also reported that average prices so far in 2025 have declined by 16 percent compared with the same period last year, reaching NOK 92.93 (EUR 7.78) per kilogram.

Meanwhile, in the United Kingdom, Scottish salmon has remained a strong performer in both domestic and export markets. Demand continues to be driven by consumer perceptions of its quality, health benefits and sustainability credentials. The sector also holds its position as the country's top food export, with high demand in key markets such as Asia, particularly China and Taiwan Province of China, where its superior quality is widely recognized. Looking ahead, the industry is monitoring the potential impacts related to the recently announced 10 percent tariff on UK fisheries and aquaculture products imports into the United States, a key trading partner. While the full effects remain to be seen, the measure has introduced a degree of uncertainty for future shipments.

Seabass and seabream



Türkiye remains competitive on price. Led by strong demand from key markets, Turkish seabass exports surged in 2024, with export value and volume rising by 14 percent and 21 percent, respectively, year-on-year. Greece emerged as the largest and fastest-growing market for the product, with export volume and value soaring by 97 percent and 83 percent, respectively.


Italy and the United States also showed significant market growth, each accounting for an 18 percent increase in Turkish seabass

export value. In contrast, export value to the Kingdom of the Netherlands fell by 13 percent. In terms of export volume, Türkiye registered increases to Italy (+20 percent) and the United Kingdom (+13 percent) as compared to the previous year.


Prices of seabass and seabream showed some increases in the month of May when compared with April, indicating that the summer demand for these species is quite strong.

Trout



As with salmon, uncertainty in the trout market has also grown following the announcement of increased US tariffs. The Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC) continues to closely monitor the situation and its potential effects on the trout trade.


According to the institution, Norway exported 6 340 tonnes of trout worth NOK 555 million (EUR 46.4 million) in April 2025. This marked a sharp increase of 53 percent in volume and a considerable 16 percent rise in value compared to the same month in 2024.

The three largest destination markets for Norwegian trout during the month were Ukraine,

the United States and Thailand. The NSC noted that April was the tenth consecutive month in which the export value of trout recorded year-on-year growth.

In addition, NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal show that HOG fresh Norwegian trout for export, FOB at the border, reached NOK 81.99 (EUR 6.86) in week 16 of 2025. This represented a notable week-on-week increase of 9.8 percent.

Following three consecutive weeks of price declines between weeks 11 and 14, prices have now registered two successive weekly increases at the time of writing.
