
Latest trends

January is a quiet month for fish consumption in Europe. On the other hand, Asia is preparing for the Chinese New Year celebrations which will begin on 16 February up to the Lantern Festival on 3 March. As a result, Asia is the main hub for major trading activity, leaving a rather soft European market characterized by declining quantities. Surprisingly though, prices continue to be high. Some classic festivity products such as live lobster and crab are being sold at moderate price levels, but many other fishery and aquaculture products report high prices. This European Fish Price Report details increases for 25 percent of the commodities and declines for 17 percent, while the remaining products report stable market conditions.







Groundfish

Norway exported 36 704 tonnes of fresh cod worth NOK 2.8 billion (USD 0.28 billion) in 2025, down by 9 percent and 11 percent, respectively, compared with the previous year. Denmark, the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Spain were the largest markets for fresh cod in 2025. As usual, exports of fresh wild cod fluctuate in line with quotas, and lower landings contributed to last year's export volume of the product being the lowest since 2009. Farmed cod accounted for a record-high share of the Norwegian export value of fresh cod in 2025. As much as 38 percent of fresh cod exports were farmed in 2025, up from 28 percent in 2024.

Norway exported 37 462 tonnes of frozen cod worth NOK 3.2 billion (USD 0.32 billion) in 2025, constituting a 5 percent year-on-year increase in value, while volume fell by 22 percent. The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, China and Viet Nam were the largest markets for frozen cod last year. Viet Nam saw the greatest growth in value in 2025, with a 38 percent increase in export value compared with the previous year.






Crustaceans



Frozen cultured shrimp from Latin America is experiencing an oversupply situation at the moment. Prices of shrimp tails have declined by EUR 0.20 per kg for all sizes. Shrimp from Argentina was in good supply, and prices have stayed stable.

Demand is low at the moment for all crustaceans, including shrimp. The prices of classic festivity products such as lobster and crab have dropped considerably from their premium levels during the Christmas period. Price declines of as much as EUR 10 per kg are seen for live lobster in the main European markets.



Trout




In 2025, Norwegian trout exports saw solid growth in both value and volume, supported by strong demand in key markets and expanded processing activity in Europe.


According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), Norway exported 86 903 tonnes of trout worth NOK 7.4 billion (EUR 639 million) during 2025. Compared with the previous year, export value increased by 10 percent, while export volumes rose by 16 percent. Ukraine, the United States and Thailand were the largest markets for Norwegian trout over the year.

Among individual destinations, Poland recorded by far the strongest growth in value, consolidating its role as a strategic market for Norwegian trout. NSC analysts attribute this expansion mainly to higher exports of processed trout products from Poland, combined with rising trout consumption in the market.

Against this strong annual backdrop, December exports showed mixed dynamics. Norway exported 6 700 tonnes worth NOK 667 million (EUR 57.6 million) in December. Compared with December 2024, export value increased by 5 percent, while volumes declined by 5 percent, indicating continued price support despite lower shipments towards the end of the year.

Price developments reflected tight market conditions. NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal indicate that prices for HOG fresh Norwegian trout, FOB at the border, reached NOK 97.34 (EUR 8.39) per kg in week 52, up 5.44 percent from the previous week. Prices remained at historically high levels into early January, standing at NOK 97.26 per kg in week 1 of 2026, broadly stable week-on-week.









Tuna

At present, the relatively low fuel cost is having a positive impact on tuna prices. In Bangkok, prices have declined by USD 50 per tonne, with all other production areas following suit and reporting a softening of price levels.

The fishing ban in Ecuador which lasted from 9 November 2025 to 19 January 2026 has come to an end and activities have started. However, no arrivals are entering the port yet. In anticipation of higher supply and lower costs, the price level in Ecuador has declined by USD 30 per tonne.

The demand for canned tuna in Europe is seasonally low at the moment as consumption of this product, which is considered an easy food item, rises during the summer months.








Small pelagics


In the last days of 2025, Norway, the United Kingdom, the Faroe Islands and Iceland reached an agreement on the 2026–2028 mackerel quota in the Northeast Atlantic after months of infighting. For the second consecutive year, the European Union, though formally chairing the consultations on the mackerel quota, was excluded from the negotiations. The deal was criticized as being a threat to the sustainability of the mackerel stock as well as undermining the legitimate interests of the EU fishing industry.

At 299 010 tonnes, the new quota is 48 percent lower than the 2025 figure, but this is still much higher than the figure of 174 257 tonnes recommended by the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES) for 2026. Following a series of bilateral agreements between the parties, the United Kingdom’s share is 30.55 percent, Norway 26.4 percent, the Faroe Islands 12 percent, and Iceland 10.5 percent. The remaining 20.55 percent of the total quota is to be shared amongst the European Union, Greenland and the Russian Federation.

With expected quota cuts and no agreement, buyers anticipate significantly reduced supply in 2026; this is already influencing contract negotiations and pricing expectations. European fishing groups warn that without a coordinated sharing arrangement, the fishery’s long-term sustainability and economic stability are at risk. Reduced TACs typically push prices upward, especially for high-quality North Atlantic product. Early signals suggest this trend is likely.



Cephalopods




Catches of squid in South Africa have improved and the fleet is back after the festive season. Little interest or stock movements are reported at the moment. The South African Rand continues to strengthen, reducing the local receipts on shipment.



Wild octopus output is under pressure in all main producing countries. Morocco – one of the world’s most important suppliers – had extended its fishing moratorium until December 2025 to protect juvenile stocks and fishing has not returned to full swing yet. This resulted in a temporary drop in global supply and firmer prices. There are strong signals that wild octopus stocks are stressed.

In Europe, octopus import prices remain at their highest level since 2018, continuing to suppress consumer demand. Many European

buyers are cautious, only placing orders based on short-term needs, as they await further price fluctuations. With Morocco’s fishing season opening, the market is closely monitoring the potential for price adjustments.

The cautious approach from European buyers is also reflective of their concerns about supply consistency. If Morocco’s 2026 fishing quotas are substantial and supply recovers steadily, the global market may enter a price stabilization phase. However, as of now, high prices are continuing to impact overall consumption patterns, particularly in Southern Europe, where octopus is a popular dish.





Salmon

According to the Norwegian Seafood Council (NSC), 2025 was a record year for Norwegian salmon exports, characterized by strong volume growth and the highest export value ever recorded, despite lower average prices compared with the previous two years.


Norway exported 1 414 909 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 124.7 billion (EUR 10.8 billion) during 2025. Compared with the previous year, export value increased by 2 percent, while export volumes rose by 13 percent. Poland, the United States of America and France were the largest markets. The result marks a new record-high annual export value, exceeding the previous peak recorded in 2024.

NSC analysts point out that favourable production conditions, including high sea temperatures, supported strong growth in output during 2025. In addition to higher total volumes, the average size of harvested fish increased, contributing to a shift in export flows towards markets with a preference for larger salmon. At the same time, the significant expansion in supply, both in Norway and globally, exerted downward pressure on prices, resulting in lower average export prices than in the previous two years.

Asia played a central role in the annual performance, with China recording the strongest growth in export value. According to the institution, this expansion reflects both rapid growth in salmon consumption in China and Norway's increasing market share, supported by new sales channels and improved distribution, including in smaller cities. Up to, and including November, China's total salmon imports from all origins were 48 percent higher than in the same period a year earlier, while Norway's share of the Chinese market increased from 41 percent to 57 percent.

Particularly in December, Norwegian exports also recorded solid export growth with 118 800 tonnes of salmon worth NOK 12.1 billion (EUR 1.05 billion), up 7 percent in volume and 8 percent in value compared to December 2024. This reflected continued momentum in key markets towards the end of the year.

Price developments were volatile in late December 2025 and early January 2026. NSC data disseminated by the Undercurrent News Price Portal show that prices for fresh Atlantic salmon, FOB at the border, peaked at NOK 109.86 (EUR 9.43) per kg in week 52, before easing to NOK 100.12 (EUR 8.59) per kg in week 1 of 2026, an 8.87 percent decline week-on-week. Despite the early-January correction, prices remained at relatively high levels, following sharp increases in the final weeks of 2025.






Seabass and seabream

Prices of seabass and seabream are reported as stable in January. This is a normal seasonal feature, as these species are not very much in demand during this time of the year.

Demand in Southern Europe, especially in Italy and Spain, is expected to remain strong in the coming months, supported by stable consumption patterns and limited availability of substitutes in the premium fresh fish segment. In addition, the upcoming Lenten season is likely to further increase demand for seabass and seabream in the Southern European countries which are home to a majority Catholic population.



At the same time, the gradual diversification of export destinations, notably the Near East, Israel

and Eastern Europe, may provide additional market outlets for producers. This might lead to price increases in the course of 2026.



The Italian clam market in January 2026 is showing a mix of strong structural demand, tight supply signals, and stable-to-firm pricing, based on the most recent available data from market reports and price-tracking sources. High domestic consumption continues to drive the market, especially for *vongole veraci* (*Ruditapes philippinarum*) used in pasta dishes and seafood mixes. Local production remains constrained due to predation by invasive blue crab, environmental pressures, lagoon management rules, and seasonal closures. Nevertheless, clams remain the largest species segment within Italy's mollusc market, reflecting their importance in both retail and foodservice as well as Italy's position as one of Europe's largest clam consumers.

Freshwater fish




The European pangasius market is in a stable but slowly strengthening phase, shaped by steady demand from the retail and foodservice sectors, competitive pricing, and ongoing shifts in consumer perception.

Europe remains one of the largest importers of pangasius, especially frozen fillets. Retailers continue to rely on it as a low-cost whitefish alternative to cod, haddock and pollock. With global pangasius prices still below many competing species, European buyers are maintaining strong interest in the commodity, particularly in Germany, Spain, the United Kingdom and Eastern Europe.


Comparatively, pangasius had faced negative press in Europe some years ago. Today, certifications and improved farming standards

have helped rebuild trust, supporting steady consumption. Supply is stable at the moment but margins are tight. Viet Nam, the dominant supplier, has maintained consistent production. However, producers face rising feed and logistics costs, which may push prices upward later in 2026.

Global forecasts show the pangasius market expanding through 2026 and beyond, with Europe contributing meaningfully to that growth. European buyers overwhelmingly prefer frozen fillets due to convenience and price stability. In addition, the expected foodservice recovery will boost demand of pangasius in coming months.
